

To qualify for standard registration rate, registration fees must be paid in full by Wednesday 27 July 2022. Registration fees received after this date will revert back to the ACD Rural Dermatology Meeting (ACD RDM) late fee rate. Registration fees are based on date of payment receipt, not the date of completion of the registration booking.

After 4 July 2022 midnight AEST, only payment made by credit card will be accepted. The overwhelming importance to The Australasian College of Dermatologists (ACD) is the health and safety of our delegates, sponsors and exhibitors, your communities and our industry. In the event of travel bans, border closures, restrictions on large gatherings, or other impacts due to Covid-19 pandemic or other conditions, the ADC RDM will move from a face to face to a virtual conference. By registering to attend, you accept that the date of the conference may change under these conditions.

If required to move to a virtual Meeting, the Conference Office will refund the difference in registration fee between the in-person fee and an appropriate virtual fee. In the case that the delegate does not wish to attend the ADC RDM virtually, the fee will be refunded less an administrative fee of AUD \$100, if the cancellation is received in writing prior to 4 July 2022.

As a condition of attendance, in-person delegates must agree to adhere to all Covidsafe measures put in place by ACD, the venue or state and acknowledge that these procedures may be changed at any time in accordance with the latest health advice from the Australian Government.

## **CANCELLATION CONDITIONS**

Cancellations received in writing at the Conference Office by 4 July 2022 will be accepted and all fees refunded less an administrative fee of AUD \$100.

Cancellations received after this date cannot be accepted and will not be refunded (in part or full).

If your application for a visa to enter Australia is unsuccessful, the above cancellation terms apply.

Transfer of registration: Transfer of your registration to another person within your organisation is acceptable. The full name and details of the person that will replace you must be advised in writing to the Conference Office prior to the ADC RDM. Non-attendance: No refunds will be made for non-attendance at the ADC RDM. Registrations are individual and cannot be shared.

Cancellation of the ADC RDM by The Australasian College of Dermatologists (ACD 2022) or Think Business Events.
