



Admission Policy

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Australasian College of Dermatologists ('College') Admission Policy is to provide a set of principles which outline the entry requirements to any College Education program.

SCOPE

This policy is applicable to all education and professional development programs offered by the College as an accredited Specialist Medical Training College, a Registered Training Organization (RTO) and as a registered Higher Education Provider (HEP).

THE POLICY

The Australasian College of Dermatologists ('College') sets entry requirements to all its programs/courses. These requirements may be based on standards set by the AMC, AHPRA, AQF, TEQSA, MBA or other regulatory bodies, or by the College and may include requirements in the areas of: English language; Education qualifications; medical work in an accredited position; Pre-requisite knowledge;

Entry requirements for each course are outlined on the website in the relevant area for that course and/or within specific Course Outlines provided to prospective students.

Applications for admission to educational programs offered by the College operating as an accredited Specialist Medical Training College will be considered and actioned by the College Trainee Selection Committee.

Applications for admission to courses offered by the College operating in its capacity as a registered Higher Education Provider (ie., TEQSA accredited courses aligned with the AQF) and as an RTO will be considered and actioned by the Academic Standards Committee (ASC).
